- 2. An important EU priority for the next 5 years
- 3. A focal point for COVID-19 recovery funds

Regardless of age/generation






Climate Change is the second biggest worry for the future.

More Needs to be Done

Socio-economic status and gender plays a role:

- **67**% of women
- 70% with a higher education
- 57% well-off financially ---> 67% humble financial situation

In reality, only (a) little has been done."






More Needs to be Done



Strongest agreement the EU is not doing enough in:

- 1. Spain (70%)
- 2. Italy **(69%)**
- 3. France (68.5%)

Policy Implications



Policies & Priorities

• **67**% agree "The EU should be stricter against companies that pollute the most in order to further combat climate change".

• **55**% agree "The EU should prioritise the environment over the economy, even if it means some jobs are lost".





Combating climate change is the second priority for the EU's COVID-19 recovery package:

COVID-19 Spending Priorities Healthcare and social services (e.g., mental health & well-being, social work, hospitals, etc.).

Combating climate change (e.g., investing in clean energy and transport, sustainable farming, etc.).








Top 3 priorities in the fight against climate change:

65% strongly support the EU reducing fossil fuel use, reducing energy dependence on outside sources and transitioning to renewables (Ukraine survey).
