European policies and budgetary instruments have been put to the test by the recent crises. This is particularly true for Cohesion Policy, which serves the purpose of fostering economic and social development in all regions of the EU but is also often asked to help endure shocks. These objectives, however, cannot be attained properly without updating instruments and means.

Ahead of the upcoming European elections and the launch of the European Commission's report on Economic, Social and Territorial Cohesion, this event reflects on the plans of the current Commission to bolster social and territorial cohesion in the EU and on the main lines of action to build a stronger and more effective EU budget. The gathering is useful to outline some of the key elements that will be brought forward to the next European legislature.

Together with EU Commissioner Elisa Ferreira and a panel of policy-making experts, the discussion will elaborate on the added value and performance of Cohesion Policy and will try to anticipate some of the difficult debates on the next Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF).
