## A HIGH LEVEL CONVERSATION TO PUBLICLY EXPLORE POSSIBLE PROGRESSIVE WAYS FOR THE EUROPEAN UNION TO SHAPE ITS FUTURE.

In a context marked by a growing disconnection between the global level of issues, and the national or local level at which they are addressed, conservatives propose the status quo. Populist movements and extremist parties, for their part, capitalize on European citizen's legitimate concerns and emotions to propose a simplistic inward looking, short term oriented and nationalistic fallback.

By bringing together a set of renowned progressive intellectuals, and basing on the results of its substantive work, FEPS intends to open a debate on the conditions that are necessary for the future European Union to effectively serve and protect its citizens and shape a good society.

For that purpose, FEPS panelists will **explore what a future progressive European Union should look like** and with what means it should be equipped to address the roots of the socio-political, digital and geo-political challenges it is facing today.

KEY QUESTIONS that will be addressed encompass the following:

- Which world are we heading to? One marked by a clash between nationalist powers, or one wherein the multilateral system is re-invented for the 21st century?
- What can be the role of the European Union to ensure better global governance in the face of the climate change, the digital revolution and people in the move?
- What is happening to the European Union itself while it is confronted to the Brexit process, mounting euro-skepticism and the resurgence of nationalist movements?
- Which new political landscape can one expect in Europe after the next European elections?
- How can pro-European progressive forces regain initiative?
- What is wrong in the current state of European integration on the economic and social fronts, but also on the political one?
- Can European democracy be re-invented? Or will digital manipulation predominate?
